CONSTRUCTION DESIGN AND MANAGEMENT REGULATIONS

POLICY STATEMENT

Genesis Composites Ltd recognise that the Construction Design and Management regulations place new duties upon Clients, Designers and Contractors and create a new duty holder - the planning supervisor. The regulations also introduce new documents - Health and Safety Plans and Health and Safety Files. All duty holders have a responsibility to ensure that Health and Safety is taken into account and managed effectively throughout all stages of a construction project.

A new approach and commitment to Health and Safety is required by all those in the construction process who can contribute to the avoidance, reduction and management of Health and Safety risks. By working together through team-work and collaboration all parties can improve Health, Safety and Welfare standards.

As Principal Contractor we have a duty to develop the Health and Safety plan and Co-ordinate the activities of all contractors to ensure they comply with Health and Safety Legislation. To check on the provision of information and training for employees and for consulting with employees, and the self employed on Health and Safety.

Our Key Tasks during the Construction phase are:-

- ❖ Develop and implement the Health and Safety plan
- ❖ Be reasonably satisfied that when arranging for a contractor to carry out construction work, they are competent and have made adequate provision for Health and Safety.
- ❖ Obtain and check method statements / risk assessments from contractors.
- ❖ Ensure the co-ordination and co-operation of contractors.
- ❖ Ensure training for Health and Safety is carried out.
- ❖ Allow only authorised people on site.
- ❖ Monitor Health and safety performance.
- ❖ Pass information to the planning supervisor for the Health and Safety file
